#### **Objectives**

- Further develop IPBES capacity-building activities for continued implementation of the rolling plan in 2018-2019.
- Support further development of the IPBES capacity-building function for the future work programme of IPBES.

#### Outputs of the task force meeting

- An overview of suggested capacity-building activities to be implemented under the capacity-building rolling plan in 2018-2019.
- Recommendations for further development of the IPBES capacity-building function for the future work programme of IPBES.

#### Context

The sixth meeting of the task force on capacity-building will be held back-to-back with the 3rd meeting of IPBES capacity-building forum (25-26 Sept) and with a one-day meeting to advance on the work of the established task groups 3-5 (27 Sept). In addition, the seventh meeting of the task force on indigenous and local knowledge and an indigenous peoples' consultation will take place in conjunction with these capacity-building meetings. The meetings will all take place 24-28 September, at UNESCO headquarters in Paris.

The aim of having all these meetings combined is to explore the links between capacity-building and I indigenous and local knowledge and discuss how to better facilitate and support the integration of indigenous and local knowledge in the work on capacity-building.
