Dialogue meeting with new IPBES members and observer States of the IPBES task force on capacity-building under the 2030 IPBES rolling work programme 18-20 April 2023

Concept note for the dialogue meeting with new IPBES members and observer States

1. Dialogue meeting with national focal points

Objective 2 of the IPBES rolling work programme up to 2030, "building capacity", aims to build capacities of individuals and institutions for a strengthened science-policy interface for biodiversity and ecosystem services. The achievement of this objective is supported by many activities and initiatives, including dialogues with national focal points under the training and familiarization programme. Governments' involvement in the work of IPBES is essential for achieving its objectives, including taking part in and contributing to the production of IPBES assessments and other products to ensure their policy-relevance, as well as the use of approved IPBES assessments and other deliverables.

The IPBES dialogue meetings bring together national focal points and other Government representatives and facilitate knowledge-sharing, peer-learning and networking among national focal points.

The first dialogue meetings were organized in 2017 as regional meetings in support of the Regional Assessments of Biodiversity and Ecosystem Services that were undertaken at that time. Since then, several dialogue meetings have been organized, both globally and regionally, in-person as well as online.

The upcoming dialogue meeting in Rome, on 18-20 April 2023 is the first dialogue meeting organized solely for new IPBES members and observers (States not members of IPBES) and builds on previously expressed interests and experiences gained from earlier dialogue meetings.

2. Objective

The objective of the upcoming dialogue is to develop capacities of new IPBES members and observers in relation to IPBES deliverables and processes and encourage IPBES membership.

To support the achievement of this objective, the meeting provides a space for sharing experiences and knowledge, as well as exploring potential collaboration and mutual support with the aim to develop increased capacities to take part in and contribute to the production of IPBES products, including IPBES assessments, as well as the use and uptake of approved IPBES assessments and other deliverables.

3. Date and venue

The dialogue meeting will take place from 18 to 20 April 2023, and is kindly hosted by the Government of Italy at the Comando unità forestali, ambientali e agroalimentari of the Carabinieri (CUFAA) in Rome, Italy.
