How do we support IPBES?

Help countries implement actions on the findings of the IPBES assessments

Support IPBES national focal points in establishing science-policy-practice platforms and triangular networks around the IPBES themes

Bring practitioners including farmers, indigenous peoples and local communities closer to biodiversity decision-making through triangular dialogue, or “Trialogues”

Apply the IPBES assessment guide to generate a body of evidence on ecosystems at the national level

Use multiple evidence to get the best available indigenous, local and scientific knowledge for national assessments

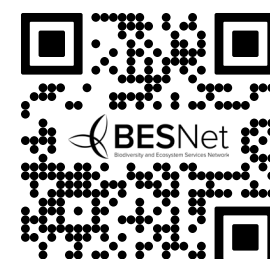
